

Emergency Drills Report Form 2016-17

Fire Prevention Act 4713 requires five (5) fire drills each school year – three (3) should be conducted by Dec 1, and two (2) drills during the remainder of the academic year. Two (2) in-building tornado safety drills (at least one (1) during March) and three (3) lock down drills (one(1) by December 1) One of drills shall take place during lunch time or when significant number of students are not in classrooms.
